Arabian Gulf: UAE - Kalba - Oil Tanker Damaged - Anchored for Lightering.

Charts BA: 3520.

Oil Tanker "New Diamond" partly damaged which might be a potential danger in the area. It is anchored, fully stable and safely afloat in position 25-04.800N, 056-26.950E (Kalba Anchorage) with escort Tugs "Boka Expedition" and Tug "POSH Commander" where Lightering operation/restoration being carried out by support vessels.

All vessels are requested to keep clear, give wide berth and communicate with the tugs on VHF Ch. 16 or with Khorfakkan Port Control on VHF Ch. 67.
