Strait of Hormuz: Sunken Landing Craft.

Charts BA: 2888, 2837.

The landing craft vessel "Kharazm" reported sank within the Strait of Hormuz and drifted to the position 26-33.20 N, 056-32.90E on 280645 UTC DEC 20.

Vessel submerged with part of about 3 meters above the water and drifting.

There was no pollution yet, but there are possibilities of leaking their bunker oil.

The Seven crew members are still missing.

Mariners are requested to navigate with extreme caution while passing in the area.
